As a member-owned cooperative, we're proud to be governed by a board of dedicated volunteers directly elected by you, our loyal members. This year, we have two well-qualified nominees who have been vetted by our Board Nominations Committee, for the open board positions.

In accordance with our credit union bylaws, all nominees who are approved for election by the Nominations Committee, may be Elected by Acclamation at the Annual Meeting, if there is only one nominee for each vacancy. Election by Acclamation is defined as an oral vote of approval taken without formal ballot. Per bylaws, no nominations shall be made from the floor at the Annual Meeting. In 2021, two candidates are running for two open Director positions on the Point West Board.
